Founded in 1997, Panamerican School is an independent Pre-K to 12th grade bilingual institution in which Spanish is the language of instruction and English and French are taught as a second and third language. It has a coed population of approximately 700 students and 75 faculty members.

The school is accredited by the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Panama.

The school year runs from February to December and is divided in three trimesters.

CURRICULUM

Panamerican School offers the same curriculum up until 9th grade. In 10th grade students choose whether to pursue a high school program in Humanities or Science. The school does not offer advanced, IB or honor courses.

Panamerican School offers a college-preparatory curriculum, which is particularly strong in Natural Sciences, Math, Computer Science and Languages. organized as follows:

- **Humanities:** Spanish, English, French, Geography, History, Civics, Ethics and Values, Logic, Philosophy, Government, Art, Music and Physical Education and a third language.
- **Science:** Arithmetic, Algebra I and II, Geometry, Trigonometry, Analytical Geometry, Calculus, Natural Sciences, Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- **Technology:** Project Management, Typing, Accounting, Computer Networking, Programming, Computer Science and Graphic Design.

GRADING

Our grading system is based on 5.00 scale, 3.00 being the minimum passing grade and 5.00 the maximum attainable.
