



ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

- IAE was established in 1955 as the first Jewish school of the country.
- We are a co-educational, college preparatory school that serves the Jewish Community from Pre Nursery up to 12th grade.
- Our school year runs from late February through Mid-December. Our seniors graduate in December every year.
- We offer advanced course work in Math, English and Hebrew.
- Our classes have a maximum of 22 students. The pupil to teacher ratio is approximately 20 to 1.
- IAE has a faculty of approximately 160 full-time teachers.
- Aside from Spanish, we teach English and Hebrew to all students grades Pre-Nursery up to 12th grade on a weekly basis.

THE STUDENT BODY

For the year 2024, IAE's student body consists of 601 students. The High School population consists of 192 students total, composed of 40 seniors, 49 juniors, 51 sophomores and 52 freshmen.

ACCREDITATION & MEMBERSHIP

IAE has been accredited by the Ministry of Education of Panama, the College Entrance Examination Board, and the Advanced Ed/Torah Umersoah. Also, we became an (IB) World School through the Middle Years Programme (MYP). Currently, we are an applicant for the Primary Years Programme (PYP).

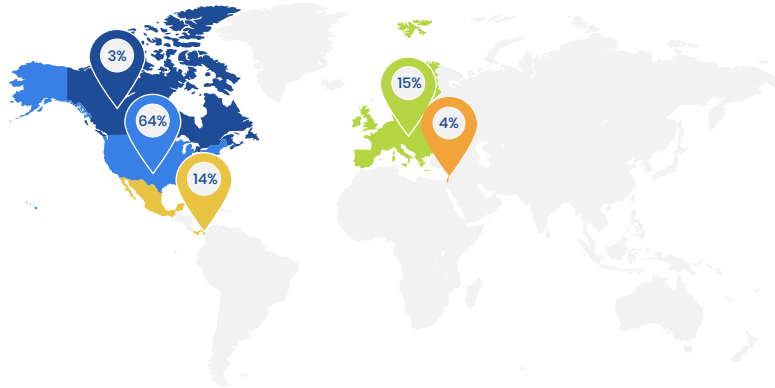
